How we deal with your data at application stage

All data from applicants is transferred into a Google spreadsheet so the selection panel can make decisions. Responses to diversity questions will be separated and shared with ScreenSkills anonymously. The selection panel do not see this information. By completing the online application form you consent to being added to the Raising Films mailing list, from which you can opt out at any time. Successful applicants will be required to create a ScreenSkills account.

How we deal with your data at decision stage

Unsuccessful applications and all associated materials and data submitted as part of the application process will be disposed of safely and in confidence. A list of successful applicants will be held by Raising Films and shared with ScreenSkills, as part of funding requirements.

Taking part

A fundamental aspect of taking part in Making In Possible online is the participation in filmed video calls. These password-protected videos are then uploaded to Raising Film's Vimeo channel with links to the videos and associated passwords shared with your Making It Possible cohort using the Slack platform. The initial 'getting to know each other' call is not recorded to allow for freedom of sharing potentially sensitive information and/or experiences.

After the course

Raising Films transfer all associated materials and data submitted by participants at application stage along with the videos created over the duration of Making It Possible to our Dropbox account. These materials are held for 12 months after the completion of Making It Possible, after which time they are disposed of safely and in confidence.
